**SUBJECT:** HV Regulations – White below the knee

### **Attention Clubs & Umpires:**

Please note the following important information from the Hockey Victoria Regulations with regards to the wearing of white below the knee for both field players and goalkeepers in HV competitions.

### **HV Rules**

#### **4. Uniforms**

- 4.1 In accordance with Hockey Australia guidelines, the wearing of predominantly white below the knee will not be permitted.

### **HV Regulations**

#### **4.4. Footwear and Socks**

All footwear worn must be suitable for the playing surface on which it is to be used and in accordance with the Hockey Australia guidelines must not be predominantly white or green.

In accordance with Hockey Australia guidelines the wearing of white below the knee is not permitted and no uniform with predominantly white socks shall be permitted after the 2005 Regular Season. However, Affiliates whose uniform includes predominantly white socks may apply to HV for an extension of time to change its uniform. No extension of time will be granted beyond the conclusion of the 2006 Regular Season.

#### **4.5. Protective Equipment**

In accordance with Hockey Australia guidelines the wearing of white below the knees is not permitted and no white goalkeeper pads or kickers shall be permitted after the 2005 Regular Season.

This Regulation has been in place for some time, therefore all clubs should be aware and ensure their players adhere to these rules.
