

Easi-Guide 5 Finals Eligibility

No player shall be eligible to play in any Finals Match unless:

They have played a minimum of thirty three and a third (33 1/3) per cent of the matches with such team or, in aggregate, a minimum of six (6) matches with such team and team(s) in a lower ranked grade(s) of the Regular Rounds of a Regular Season competition for that club, and

They have played a simple mathematical majority (including all Designated Substitute matches) of their matches in that team or in teams in lower ranked grades of the Regular Rounds of a Regular Season competition for that club.

Openage/Overage Competitions

Example

Player A has played 8 matches with **B GRADE** and has played 9 matches with **A GRADE** (including DS/Permit games), player A is therefore ineligible to play finals with Pennant B as they have played a majority with the higher grade, **A GRADE**.

Notes:

Should a player transfer clubs during the season, the former club's matches **do not count** in determining finals eligibility.

Matches played as a designated substitute **do count** towards finals eligibility.

Matches played as a permit player **do count** towards finals eligibility.
